WEATHER MAY/JUNE/JULY/AUG

A noticeable drop in ocean temperature occurs, weather is cooling down heading into winter.

Weather can be extremely unpredictable and the island is heavily influenced by east coast low-pressure systems, bringing extremely strong winds, rain and cooler temperatures. Weather patterns between low-pressure cells can provide a calm windless phenomenon often referred to as the June Lull.

August is often the windiest month of the year.

Walking Tracks:

Lord Howe Island has a number of World class walking tracks, each with its own amazing view. Each of these walks can be viewed on the LHI walking track map, which also has details on duration and degree of difficulty listed.

Great Walks of Australia has also recently recognised the 7 peaks walk (operated by Pinetrees) as one of their great walks. So make sure you pack your walking shoes.

Coral Viewing:

The water temp of the Lagoon during Winter is ~20°C, with a wetsuit you can comfortably snorkel our amazing coral reefs. Whether it be, at Neds Beach right from the beach or on our Ultimate Snorkelling tour, taking you to 4 different spots on the World's southern most coral reef.

If you are not so keen on getting in the water, we also have a Coral Viewing Tour that runs all year round and caters to those wanting to see Lord Howe's unique marine life without being in the water. An optional 30min snorkel is included on this trip and as with all our tours all snorkelling gear and wetsuits are included in the price (our tours are weather dependant, so it's wise to note, if the weather is good don't miss your chance by putting it off, our walking tracks can be done in any weather but out water-based activities need good weather conditions.)

ESSENTIAL TRAVEL INFO

When travelling to Lord Howe Island, travel insurance is highly recommended. As Lord Howe Island is a small Island, weather patterns can change dramatically over the course of your stay, especially during winter months. To ensure you are covered in the event of a flight change or weather cancellation we think travel insurance is essential.

Remember you are travelling during Winter, our weather, although slightly warmer is very similar to the East coast of Australia so inclement weather on the East coast or on Lord Howe Island may result in flight changes.

During this season many tour operators and restaurants are closed. Research tour options before booking travel to the island.
