## WEATHER DEC/JAN/FEB

### December

The season is starting to warm up, with more reliable, calmer, weather patterns prevailing.

### January

Lord Howe is starting to feel more like a tropical island, with warmer ocean temperatures and calmer weather conditions typical of this month.

Has two defined weather possibilities consisting of prolonged dry and calm weather patterns through to severe low pressure systems which bring heavy rain and strong winds. The humidity level increases significantly during this month.
